OBSERVATION -- As a group, talk through and summarize the passage. Think through *Who, What, Where, When, How, Why* questions together.

INTERPRETATION -- Answer these questions together:

1) What does this passage teach us about Jesus?

a) Think through these 4 truths from the sermon together:

1. Jesus is the king you can trust.
2. Jesus has dealt with all your sins at the cross.
3. Jesus will return and make everything new.
4. Jesus offers rest for your soul today.

b) Which of these truths stand out to you/comforts you?

2) What does this passage teach us about us (mankind)?

a) How can we be like the crowds on Palm Sunday wanting a Savior from our circumstances rather than a Savior from our sin?

b) Are you overwhelmed or underwhelmed by the current quarantine situation? In what ways do you need to find rest?

3) What does this passage teach us about salvation/grace? How does it point to Christ?

a) What does it mean to you that Jesus comes gentle and humble offering peace and rest?

b) What does it mean to you that Jesus will return in victory and renew all things?

APPLICATION

Read Matthew 11:28-30. How can you find rest for your soul this week?

PRAYER

Praise God for his kingdom of peace and rest.

Confess your areas where you are overwhelmed or underwhelmed?

Ask God for the courage to rest in his saving grace.
