Facing Our Fears: Fear of Failure

- 1. Luke 12:13 The way of the world is selfish and desiring to get as much money/possessions as possible.
- 2. Luke 12:15 Jesus warns against thinking success in life is based on our ability to gather a lot of stuff.
- 3. Luke 12:16-21 The things the world value as success results in being completely broke (poor) in God's view.
- 4. Luke 12:22-30 The things that consume the world do not need to be your focus. God knows your needs and will care for you.
- 5. Luke 12:31-34 True success is found in seeking the kingdom of God. Trust Jesus as Savior and follow Him as Lord.
- 6. Romans 8:37-39 Do not fear, your failures cannot separate you from God and His love.
- Philippians 1:6 Do not fear, God begins the work in all His children and He will be faithful to complete it. Guaranteed success in Christ.
