Notes from Today's Lesson:

Facing Our Fears: Fear of Rejection

- 1. Matthew 25:41-46 The only rejection we should fear is from God and falling short of His expectation.
- 2. Romans 3:23 We deserve rejection because we all fall short. We deserve God's wrath to be poured out on us.
- 3. Romans 5:1 Jesus' sacrifice on the cross brings us peace with God and complete acceptance.
- 4. Romans 5:2 For those who trust in Jesus, we live under God's grace instead of facing His just wrath, and are accepted into His kingdom forever.
- 5. Luke 10:1, 6 Do not fear rejection as you live each day following God, sharing his love and truth. The lost world is struggling with God and rejecting Him, not just you.
- 6. 2 Corinthians 5:18-20 Because we are fully accepted by the One that matters most, we can go out boldly, without fear, as God's ambassadors to the lost world.

Devotional #1: Saved From God

Read Matthew 25:31-46

What does this passage show us about God's expectation on us in order to be accepted?

Have you always been loving, caring, looking out for others, and doing what is right?

What is the price of falling short of God's expectation?

This passage shows us that need to be saved from our sin. We are imperfect and cannot live up to God's expectations perfectly. We need saved from the wrath (the punishment) of God.
