

Notes from Today's Lesson:

Facing Our Fears: Fear of Loneliness

1. 1 Kings 19:1-3 — Elijah was afraid of the queen and ran for his life.
2. 1 Kings 19:4-6 — Elijah wanted to give up on living, but God sent an angel to care for him.
3. 1 Kings 19_9-10 — Elijah tells God about his fears and that he feels completely alone.
4. 1 Kings 19:11-13 — God shows Elijah that he is not alone and blesses Elijah with His presence.
5. 1 Kings 19:15-18 — God tells Elijah that he is not alone and lets him know many will stand with him.
6. Ephesians 4:4-6 — We have one God, one hope, and one body of believers so we are not alone.
7. Ephesians 4:11-16 — We are called to come, grow, and work together as one body of Jesus Christ.

Devotional #1: Honoring and Obeying Your Parents

Read Ephesians 6:1-3

What are children commanded to do in this passage?

Doing good and being obedient doesn't save you from the guilt and penalty of sin. Jesus did that on the cross. So why should you obey your parents?
