Facing Our Fears: Fear of Following

- 1. Matthew 16:21 Jesus demonstrates what trusting God and denying oneself looks like as He commits to going to the cross.
- 2. Matthew 16:22-23 Peter's response shows a lack of trust and the sin of putting oneself first in an attempt to avoid suffering.
- 3. Matthew 16:24 Jesus commands His followers to trust God, put God first, and continue to follow God.
- 4. Matthew 16:25-26 The price of looking out for yourself only and only following your desires is missing out on life with God.
- 5. Matthew 16:27 Trust God, and find hope and strength in His promises.
