

## Notes from Today's Lesson:

### Thirst for God: John 4 and Isaiah 55:1-13

1. John 4:10 — Jesus offers living water for all who come to God, trusting He can satisfy their spiritual thirst.
  2. Isaiah 55:1-3 — God offers us the only thing that will satisfy us that money and work cannot buy, living water.
  3. Isaiah 55:6-7 — We are called to thirst for God and seek His salvation. God promises to forgive us and cover us with His mercy and grace.
  4. Isaiah 55:8-9 — We are called to trust in God's infinite wisdom. He is in control and able to redeem us through His Son, Jesus.
  5. Isaiah 55:12-13 — God promises complete joy in Him and a day when He will redeem all creation.
- ◇ Have you felt the emptiness inside like the woman at the well?
  - ◇ Do you understand that the emptiness is there because of separation from God and only God can fill it?
  - ◇ Do you thirst for God and want Him to help you grow in being satisfied in Him alone?
