

## Notes from Today's Lesson:

### The Power of Jesus, Who Is God

1. Mark 5:22-23 — A Jewish leader, Jairus, comes to Jesus, trusting Jesus can heal his daughter who is dying.
2. Mark 5:24-28 — A woman touches Jesus, trusting Jesus can heal her from her physical suffering.
3. Mark 5:29-34 — The woman is healed because of the power of Jesus.
4. Mark 5:35 — People come to tell Jairus that hope is lost, since his daughter is already dead.
5. Mark 5:36 — Jairus is challenged by Jesus to continue to trust and not fear.
6. Mark 5:38-40 — Those mourning the death of the girl mock Jesus and do not trust in Him.
7. Mark 5:40-42 — The girl is raised to life because of the power of Jesus.

God calls us to trust Him:

- ◇ Trust His salvation.
- ◇ Trust His provision.
- ◇ Trust His plan.

### Devotional #1: God's Compassion

Read Mark 5:21-24

Why do you think the crowd was following Jesus?

Why did Jairus come to Jesus and why would he think Jesus would do anything to help him?

Why did Jesus think He could help Jairus, and why would He choose to go with Him?

### Devotional #2:

#### Faith in Jesus

Read Mark 5:25-34

What motivated the woman to touch Jesus?

Why do you think Jesus allowed His power to be used to heal this woman?

What did the woman "do" to get better?

God will not always heal us from our physical suffering in this life, but He promises to be with us and help us so we will not face our struggles alone. Why should we go to God for help, and what do you think God requires of us to receive His care?
