Notes from Today's Lesson:

In The Face of Suffering, Rest in Jesus

- 1. John 9:1-2 The pain of suffering is evident in the blind man's life.
- 2. John 9:18-24 The pain of the blind man's suffering, even after receiving sight, seems to be endless.
- 3. John 5:14 Suffering can be a result of sin in our lives.
- 4. John 9:3-5 In this case, suffering was for the purpose and glory of God.
- 5. Romans 8:28 We can have hope that God will work out His plan for good.
- 6. John 9:6-7, 35-38 God's plan is greater than physical relief; the man's life was changed forever.
- 7. Romans 8:18 Jesus provides each of us hope for the future for those who trust in Him, an eternal life in His presence, in His kingdom.
- We all face the pain of suffering in this life.
- We need to trust God has a purpose in our suffering and can use it for good.
- We can have the power to endure suffering in this life because of Jesus.


