Notes from Today's Lesson: Not Our Plan, but God's

- Matthew 21:1-3 Jesus, as God, knew a future conversation, response, and event before it ever happened. Jesus does not guess the future, but as God, He knows it.
- 2. Matthew 21:4-5 Jesus does not use His power for personal fun, but to fulfill the plan of God as recorded in God's Word hundreds of years before.
- 3. Matthew 21:6-7 The disciples trusted Jesus and followed His plan.
- 4. Matthew 21:8-11 The crowd celebrated Jesus as a prophet and king; however, they hoped Jesus came as a conquering king.
- 5. Isaiah 53:3 Part of God's plan was that Jesus would be rejected.
- 6. Isaiah 53:5-6 God's plan was not for Jesus to conquer Rome, but for Him to conquer sin and death. Our greatest need is not freedom from people, but freedom from the punishment we deserve for sin.
- Whose plan was best, the crowd's or God's? Why?
- Where can you learn more about God's plan?
- How can you balance making plans and yet trusting God and His plan?
