OBSERVATION -- As a group, talk through and summarize the passage. Think through *Who, What, Where, When, How, Why* questions together.

INTERPRETATION -- Answer these questions together:

1) What does this passage teach us about God?

a) When you read about the conversion of Paul what stands out to you about the redemptive plan of God?

2) What does this passage teach us about us?

a) In what way was your own conversion and calling different from Paul's? How was it similar to Paul's?

b) How would you describe your attitude toward the Great Commission? How would you describe your actions regarding the Great Commission?

3) What does this passage teach us about grace/salvation? How does it point to Christ?

a) How do we see Jesus acting in Acts 9? In what way is the conversion of Saul all of grace?

APPLICATION

a) Have you heard King Jesus' call to "go there (to the ends of the earth)?" See Matthew 28:19-20. What can you learn from Paul about the mission to "go there?"

b) Have you heard King Jesus' call to "go here?" How can you be an Ananias? Remember these three ways Garret shared with us: Accompany, Encourage, Imitate. What specifically can you do in one of these areas?

FIGHTER VERSES: James 1:16-22.

- Praise God for his plan to reach the world with the gospel of Jesus Christ.
- Confess ways that you have ignored the great commission of King Jesus.
- Thank Jesus for his grace in saving you.
