

Sermon: Count One Another More Significant.
Series: *One Another*.

Scripture: Philippians 2:1-11.
Date: August 14, 2022

OBSERVATION -- As a group, talk through and summarize the passage. Think through *Who, What, Where, When, How, Why* questions together.

INTERPRETATION -- Answer these questions together:

1. What does this passage teach us about God?

a) How is the glory of God displayed in this passage? How do we display the glory of God according to this passage?

2. What does this passage teach us about us?

a) Pastor Jamie talked a lot about our pride. Where have you seen your pride ("selfish ambition or conceit") get in the way of treating others as more significant than yourself?

b) Phil. 2:1 describes us in Christ. How are we described? Do you think these things describe you? What makes it difficult or easy to see yourself this way?

3. What does this passage teach us about grace/salvation? How does it point to Christ?

a) Re-read Phil. 2:7-8. How would you explain that Jesus emptied himself for us?

b) Re-read Phil. 2:8. Why is it so important that not only did Jesus die for us but that he died on a CROSS for us? What does this teach us about our need of salvation?

APPLICATION

a) Is there a specific place where you need to "look on the interest of others?" Why is being in community necessary for this to happen?

b) How would you treat Jesus if he came to your house? How does your answer to this impact how you will treat others this week?

FIGHTER VERSES: Philippians 2:5-8.

PRAYER

- Thank God for his exaltation of Christ and for his exaltation of us by sharing Christ's mind with us.
- Confess ways that you have been selfish, proud, conceited with others.
- Thank Jesus for humbling himself to the point of the cross.
- Ask God to help you to look out for the interests of others this week.
